Last week, our assembly focused on how we can use our **PROUD** values to shape our thinking. ### **AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES**

Please can we remind parents to book their child's place at our After-School Activities for this term as soon as possible. To do this, go to <a href="https://jameswolfe.schoolactivity.co.uk">https://jameswolfe.schoolactivity.co.uk</a>, where you will be asked to create an account (if you don't already have one -- for example, to book Breakfast Club). You will then be able to select and pay for an activity for your child. Activities have varying availability (between 10 and 30 places) and prices (from £2.50 to £5.00 per session). Places are booked on a first-come, first served basis.

If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you will need to create an account (as above), if you have not already done so for Breakfast Club, then email the school at <a href="mailto:admin@jameswolfe.greenwich.sch.uk">admin@jameswolfe.greenwich.sch.uk</a> to advise that your account has been set up. We will then amend your account so that you do not have to pay for activities and then notify you that your account has been amended. The parent should then log back into their account to select the activity for their child, choosing 'Pay venue directly' when checking out, meaning payment will not be requested. Please note that if you do not notify the school you have set up your account and your child is eligible for Pupil Premium, you will not be able to book an activity without paying.

### **GDPR SIGN-UP**

The school office regularly hears from parents/carers who are not subscribed to the Weekly Wolfe mailing list and so are not up-to-date with school information. Due to GDPR regulations, any parent/carer who has not given specific permission for us to use their email address to circulate school notices (including the Weekly Wolfe) will not receive them. #### **PUPIL ASSET**

Parents are able to edit their own details in Pupil Asset, so, if you have switched phone numbers or even spot a mistake, there is now no need to make a request from the school office, you can just log in and make the change yourself.

Dinner payments via Pupil Asset are currently suspended – please look out for information on how to pay in the very near future.

To log in to Pupil Asset, parents can either download their Parent App or log in to their ParentPortal. To create a password for the ParentPortal, please go to http://parents.pupilasset.com/ and select Login Via ParentPortal, then First Time Login. Alternatively, you can download their app, either for iPhone from https://apps.apple.com/gb/app/pupil-asset-parent-app/id1490994393, or for Android from <a href="https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.rnparentapp">https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.rnparentapp</a>. Tap First Login then enter the email address we have on record for you. When you tap Submit, PA will send you an email which will allow you to set your password. Your password will need to be at least eight characters long and include a number, or you will be unable to log in. Please inform us if your email address has changed. Once you have created login details you will be able to sign in with them on the Login screen. Full instructions can be found at https://www.pupilasset.com/help/how-to-guide/parental-communicationcontactsemailsmspattr-/parents-app-overview-a-quide-for-parents. The app/portal will initially only be used for dinner payments -- you will not, for example, be able to select meals as demonstrated in the guide and, indeed, our rules regarding this will remain the same.

### **MEDICATION IN SCHOOL**

Medication for children can only be accepted by the School Office if:

- 1) The medication has a **prescription label** stuck to it detailing the child's name.
- 2) The Parental Agreement for School/Setting to Administer Medicine form has been fully filled in, signed by the parent and handed in with the medication.
  3) The medication is in date.

Please note, parents are responsible for making a note of the expiry date and replacing medicine when required.

**Two Epipens** are needed in school for children requiring them.

For Antibiotics, the prescription label must say it needs to be given **four** times a day.
