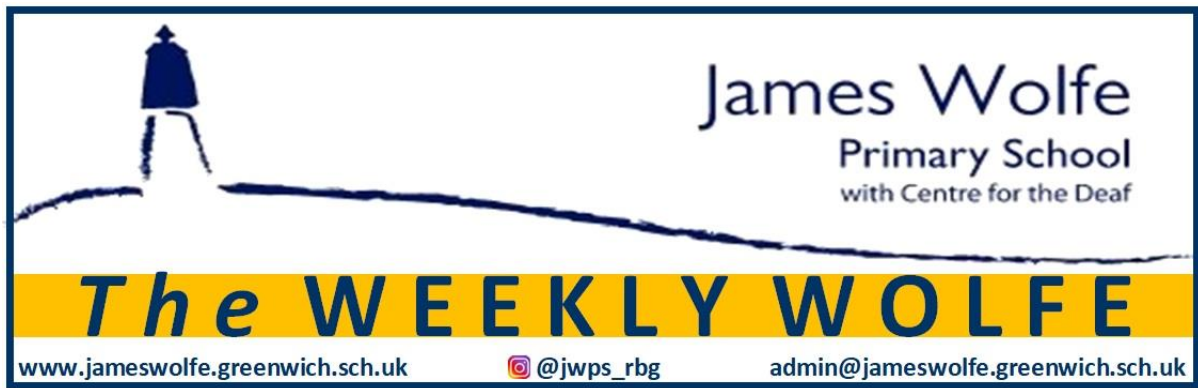

AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

This term's after-school activities will commence next week, beginning Monday 24th January, and run for nine weeks. **Bookings opened this morning at 9am.** Activities have varying availability (between 20 and 30 places) and prices (from £2.50 to £5.00 per session). **Places are booked on a first-come, first served basis, so please ensure you set up your account beforehand and then book as close to midday today (when bookings open) as possible.** **Parents of children eligible for the benefit Free School Meals, who are entitled to one free activity, should contact the school office after setting up their account.**

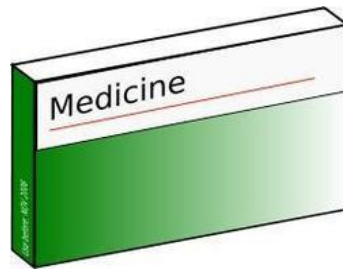
Special Conditions: There is a confidentiality component to this role and the post holder needs to undertake the duties of this role in a strictly professional manner.

MEDICATION IN SCHOOL

Medication for children can only be accepted by the School Office if:

- 1) The medication has a **prescription label** stuck to it detailing the child's name.
- 2) The **Parental Agreement for School/Setting to Administer Medicine** form has been fully filled in, signed by the parent and handed in with the medication.
- 3) The medication is **in date**.

Please note, parents are responsible for making a note of the expiry date and replacing medicine when required.

Two Epipens are needed in school for children requiring them.

For Antibiotics, the prescription label must say it needs to be given **four** times a day.



BIKES & SCOOTERS

It's wonderful to see so many children scooting and cycling to school - however, for safety reasons, we ask that children do not ride them in the playground before or after school.



SICKNESS

We remind all parents that, if your child is absent unwell, this must be reported to the school every day that they do not attend. Children should not return to school until **48 hours after their last incidence of vomiting or diarrhoea.**

We thank all parents for their ongoing support with this.



OUT OF HOURS

A number of organisations use our space to deliver their programmes out of school hours, including Young Education Services and the Anna Fiorentini Theatre School, a German school, Bananadrama, a soul choir, Spanish classes, the Angelina Jandolo Ballet School, Link Chinese school, Bounce exercise classes, ISK Karate Club, Sabia Duvida Portuguese School and the Greenwich Historical Society. BREAKFAST CLUB BOOKING

Breakfast Club is available for booking via our online booking system, with bookings by the day, week or term available. Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis and are limited. To book, please go to the SchoolHire website at <https://jameswolfe.schoolactivity.co.uk>. If you would like to cancel a booking, please request this from the school office, who will generate an automatic refund for any session that has not yet taken place. Please note, however, that only whole bookings can be cancelled, not individual days from a booking -- we would have to cancel the whole booking and you would then have to re-book for just the days you require.

Please can we remind parents that pupils must arrive for Breakfast Club by 8:30am.

The charge for the week remains at £12.50 (£2.50 per day), which must be paid when making the booking. **Parents with Pupil Premium children or those who wish to pay with childcare vouchers must contact the school office before setting up a SchoolHire account, or they will be charged as normal.**
