

Dear Parents,



During our PROUD award assemblies, I often ask the children and staff to take a moment to think about the things that they are thankful for, and to highlight the positive effects that this can have on our mental well-being. I encourage them to think of three things (they can sometimes find three quite challenging), which helps everyone to focus on being mindful of where we are and what we are doing, and to really think about all of the things that we are truly grateful for.

As I was listening to some examples during one of these assemblies, I started to think about the two words 'grateful' and 'thankful' and I asked the question "What is the difference between gratitude and thankfulness?" A quick scan through the dictionary found an interesting distinction between the two terms -- whereas 'thankful' is defined as being "pleased about something good that has happened, or that something bad has not happened", the word 'grateful' focuses more on the act of "showing appreciation of kindness and wanting to express thanks". Therefore, the difference is that while thankful is a feeling, being grateful is an action.

So, as we near the weekend and our thoughts turn to Mothering Sunday, many of us will be thinking about the amazing, strong and caring women in our lives, whose love, support and dedication have made us who we are today. Whether you are celebrating your mum, aunt, sister, niece, cousin, friend or next door neighbour, we all have someone whom we are *thankful* for and can show our *gratitude* to.

I wish you a wonderful weekend in the sunshine – that is something we can all most certainly be thankful for!
















Calling all young artists!
