KS2 SATs Week will take place for all Year 6 nationwide between Monday 9<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May during normal school hours.

Monday 9 <sup>th</sup> May	Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation tests. Paper 1 (Questions): 45 mins Paper 2 (Spelling): 15 mins (approx)
Tuesday 10 <sup>th</sup> May	Reading test. 1 hour
Wednesday 11 <sup>th</sup> May	Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic): 30 mins Paper 2 (Reasoning): 40 mins
Thursday 12 <sup>th</sup> May	Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning): 40 mins
Friday 13 <sup>th</sup> May	<b>No tests</b>

Our Year 6 children have worked extremely hard this term in preparation for SATs; we are so PROUD of how maturely they have applied themselves. Please reassure children if they are worried: as long as they are giving their best each day then there is nothing more we can ask of them!

All children must be in school at the normal time each day. **Please telephone the school immediately if your child might be late.**

If your child were to miss a SATs test, they would need to complete that paper at a separate time to the rest of their year group. Therefore, if there is need for an urgent medical appointment, please ensure it is booked for the **afternoon**. This will reduce disruption and ensure your child partakes alongside their peers.

Please ensure that children have a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast each day to best prepare them for their busy week! We will also be offering children the opportunity to attend SATs Breakfast Club from 8:15am (information to follow after the Easter holiday).
