Dear Parents,

It has been lovely to see the children now settled and back into the swing of their learning. Play equipment: We ask that play equipment is not used before or after school.

Snacks: The children are offered fruit and vegetables for their snack each day. However, if you are providing your child with one from home, please do remember that this should be a healthy snack that enables them to concentrate when they return to their learning, rather than sugary biscuits and treats which do not help the children to focus.
